Guidelines for Student Volunteers (Grades 3-12) in Children's Ministries

Any student wishing to help in our Children's Ministries needs to have a parent's permission to do so. Both the student and the parent need to read and agree to abide by the following guidelines:

Students in grades 6-12 may help out in a class with the Children's Ministry Pastor's permission. Students grades 3-5 will only be allowed to help in a class alongside their parent.

Students will be scheduled to serve based on communicated availability and are strongly encouraged to attend one service and serve for the other.

Students will remain in the classroom for the duration of the program they are helping with, unless asked to move to another classroom. (No switching back and forth between classes or wandering around the halls.)

If a student is behaving inappropriately, the parent or supervising adult will take the student aside and direct the student as to the proper behavior.

Students will always work alongside an adult, and **never** be left alone with the children.
